Each oral presentation is a solo performance. Part of your oral presentation is a 10 minute review of a previously covered topic. You will also spend 5 minutes describing a topic that is new to the class. Tie this new topic into your review material and discuss how it relates to your review topic. New topics may be new material altogether or an in depth example. It should be accompanied by a handout which gives a general outline of the topics covered.

Each oral presentation is to be followed by a written version of your material incorporating comments and corrections that may have been made at the time of the oral presentation. Collaboration on these written assignments is prohibited. I expect the written assignment to be long enough to thoroughly discuss your topic, reiterate the review and how describe how the new ties into the old.
