Assessment Item	Description	Notes	Score
Incorporated Feedback (5 points)	This requirement may be fulfilled by (successfully) arguing with your teacher about the feedback before the day of the lesson, or by simply incorporating the feedback.		
Technical Accuracy (10 points)	There should not be (m)any technical errors in your lesson. Any that do happen should be corrected quickly.		
Clarity and Accessibility (10 points)	Material is presented clearly, precisely, and logically. Examples are well explained. Technical material presented is accessible to students.		
Student Questions (5 points)	Were you able to answer student questions clearly?		
Objectives Met (5 points)	You set out a goal for your lesson with your objectives. Did you meet them (or make progress towards meeting them)?		
Supporting Your Objectives (5 points)	Do the problems/examples you have ultimately selected for your lesson support students in achieving the learning objectives?		
Pacing (7 points)	Were you careful to slow down and leave pauses for student questions?		
Nitty-Gritty (3 points)	Did class get out on time? Was the entire class period utilized?
